The African-American Special Interest Group (AA-SIG) provides a forum for society members and the public to network, share genealogical research, study, and preserve the history of African-American interests.



Directed research meetings consist of roundtable discussions, research assistance, and occasional speakers or tours. Held quarterly, the meetings alternate between the St. Louis County Library Headquarters (SLCL) and the downtown branch of the St. Louis Public Library (SLPL).

Meetings are scheduled the second Saturday each quarter, unless noted, from 11 a.m. to 12 noon for roundtable discussion, then from noon to 1 p.m. for research assistance or continued roundtable discussion.
