Of our 319 ancestor families whose date of immigration to the New World is known, 49% immigrated during the period 1841-1860.																																			
Of our 459 ancestor families whose origin in Ireland is known at least to some extent, 17% lived in the province of Ulster (north), 20% in Leinster (east), 36% in Munster (south), and 27% in Connaught (west). (The most prevalent counties are Cork, Galway, Mayo, Limerick, and Tipperary.)																																			
Of our 184 ancestor families whose port of entry to the New World is known, 51% entered through New York City, 18% through New Orleans, 10% through Philadelphia, and 13% through Boston.																																			
Of our 462 ancestor families whose state of first residence is known, 58% first settled in the Midwest.																																			
The Table State 1st Res vs Port and Chart State 1st Res vs Port show a cross-reference for those ancestor families whose port of entry and state of first residence are both known.																																			
Of our 47 ancestor families known to have first settled in Missouri whose port of entry is known, 23 entered through NYC, 15 New Orleans, 3 Boston, 2 Baltimore, 2 Albion, 1 Philadelphia, and 1 Toronto.																																			
Of our 18 ancestor families known to have first settled in Illinois whose port of entry is known, 8 entered through New Orleans, 8 NYC, 1 Portland, Maine, and 1 Proton, Ontario.																																			
Of our 23 ancestor families known to have first settled in Pennsylvania whose port of entry is known, 13 entered through Philadelphia, 9 through New York City, and 1 through Baltimore.																																			
Of our 30 ancestor families known to have first settled in New York state whose port of entry is known, 28 entered through New York City, 1 through Portland, and 1 through Quebec.																																			
The Table County vs Departure Port and Chart County vs Departure Port show a cross-reference for those ancestor families whose county of origin and departure port are both known.																																			
Of our 12 ancestor families known to have departed from Queenstown whose county of origin is known, 3 each lived in Galway and Mao, 2 lived in Cavan, and 1 each lived in Kerry, Kildare, Louth, and Waterford.																																			
Of our 4 ancestor families known to have departed from Derry whose county of origin is known, 3 lived in Tyrone and 1 lived in Donegal.																																			
The Port of Entry table provides clues of where to look for a port of entry if a state of 1st residence is known. There a ship's manifest might be found which identifies the port of departure.																																			
Arrival records are kept by Port of Entry. The ship's manifest almost always identifies the port of departure.																																			
The Port of Departure can then be used to provide clues to likely Irish counties of origin, where records related to the ancestor family might be located.
