I. WHAT WAS HISTORICAL PRUSSIA?

- Mainly portions of modern Germany & Poland
- For most of its history, Prussia was a duchy, a kingdom & a free state
- Boundaries of Prussia shifted frequently over time

II. PRUSSIA'S EVOLUTION OVER TIME: A SIMPLIFIED TIMELINE

- **PRE-1226** OLD PRUSSIANS
- **1226-1525** TEUTONIC MONASTIC STATE
- 1525-1618 DUCHY OF PRUSSIA
- 1618-1701 BRANDENBURG-PRUSSIA
- **1701-1772** KINGDOM IN PRUSSIA
- **1772-1918** KINGDOM OF PRUSSIA
 - ♦ (1871 GERMAN UNIFICATION)
- **1918-1947** FREE STATE OF PRUSSIA

III. SEARCHING FOR YOUR PRUSSIAN ANCESTORS

- If you have German roots, you may have Prussian roots as well
- Search for the ancestral location *first,* especially before German Unification
- Become familiar with the basics of Prussian geography and history
- Use gazetteers for historical, jurisdictional info. in the pursuit of records
- Focus on church records, especially before German Unification
- Apply examples from the Prussian case study to your own research
